New Business:

D. Compton discussed the new AHA CPR and AED recommendations. He noted that many manufacturers have offered to reprogram some AED's, but each department will need to contact the manufacturer for details. He noted that the Barry County OEM would continue to use the American Safety and Health Institute's curriculum. ASHI will be updating their material to the latest AHA guidelines. While AHA sets the guidelines and has very good material they have become cost prohibitive.

D. Compton discussed the upcoming regionalization committee meeting to be held in Springfield. He noted that the committee would make recommendation to the State Homeland Security Committee on funding priorities for our Region. He noted that there would be 15 members on the Region D Homeland Security Committee. There will be representation from the LEPC's, M. Conn made a motion that the Executive Committee make a recommendation on behalf of this LEPC. G. Burton 2nd the motion and the motion passes unanimously.

J. Kelley reported that she will be attending training at the Noble Training Center in Atlanta GA.
