He noted that Mulvaney was one of the organizers of the Barry/Lawrence LEPD, as well as having served the City of Monett for over 50yrs as both a Firefighter and Emergency Preparedness Coordinator. Gene received many honors, including Recognition by the Missouri House of Representatives, Lifetime Achievement Award from the Missouri Emergency Preparedness Association, and recognition Awards from the Southwest Missouri Emergency Services Organization, and the Barry/Lawrence LEPD.

Discussion was had on if the LEPD can pay tuition and expenses to the annual 4 corners Emergency Management Conference. D. Compton will make inquiry with the MERC to see if that is an appropriate expenditure.

J. Frank reported that the RHSOC has received 2 corral systems one located in Lawrence County and one Located in Polk County, the Regional Communications Vehicles have been delivered to Greene County and Jasper County, and there will be a regional pet sheltering meeting in Mt Vernon.
